INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS - NORTH

ONE YEAR AGREEMENT AND FREEZE OF WAGES REACHED WITH THE IRON WORKERS: Earlier in March, Mark Reynosa - Field Services Manager for IR North reported that “the AGC Industrial Relation Departments, in conjunction with the California Ironworker Employers Council, met on January 27, 2010, with the District Council of Iron Workers over negotiations for a new successor labor agreement. During the course of the discussions, a tentative settlement agreement was reached. In short summary, the settlement agreement calls for a new one-year extension of the current 2007-2010 Master Labor Agreement without any changes or modifications to the language and without any increases (freeze) to wages or fringe benefits at the 2009-2010 rates. The expiration date of this new extended labor agreement is June 30, 2011.” Additionally, between Northern and Southern AGC Industrial Relation Departments, nine other Master Labor Agreements will be negotiated.
