CARB UPDATE: In a press release from the Air Resources Board (ARB), the Board has begun the process of revising its tactic to clean up off road regulations for construction equipment. The unforeseen downturn in the economy has contributed to a lessening of operating construction equipment, which in turn has affected the amount of air emissions. The Board has directed staff to come up with some proposed changes on the current regulations, while taking the current state of the economy into detail. A series of workshops will be held throughout California to collect information, and the revisions are scheduled to be presented to CARB Board members in September.
