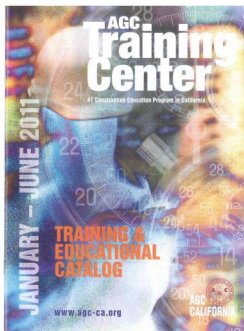

## SAN FRANCISCO BAY AREA

**LOCAL HIRE:** In late October, San Francisco Supervisor John Avalos introduced local San Francisco legislation which would require San Francisco Bay Area contractors to meet a local hiring goal of 30-50 percent. The AGC San Francisco Bay Area district has been working with local Labor and agencies to address this issue of local hire, which has the potential to affect many contractors who do work or may be planning to perform work in the city of San Francisco. AGC will be meeting with the San Francisco Mayor's Chief of Staff to discuss this legislation proposed by Supervisor Avalos. The goal of this meeting is to discuss what is workable for San Francisco contractors, and to see if an agreement can be made between Labor and the city.
