***** TEAMSTERS AND TUNNEL LABORERS AGREEMENTS REACHED WITH UNIONS*****

Please be advised that after eight months of negotiations, the AGC's Teamsters negotiations committee in conjunction with EUCA and AECE have reached and ratified a new agreement with the Teamsters union. The settlement agreement calls for a new three year labor agreement, effective June 16, 2010 through June 30, 2013, with a freeze to wages and a \$3.50 total fringe benefit package increase.

Additionally, AGC and the Laborers have approved and ratified a new two year successor Tunnel Labor Agreement, effective July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2012. The agreement calls for a July 1, 2010 increase of one dollar and fifteen cents, and a July 1, 2011 increase of one dollar and twenty-nine cents.
