Labor's response to the concerns raised on the Conference Call held Thursday, May 7, 2020, to address Section 11 of the Collective Bargaining Agreement is as follows;

Labor acknowledges that Section 11 of our Collective Bargaining Agreement addresses the following Paid Leave Ordinances;

- The California Statewide Paid Leave Ordinance
- San Francisco Public Health Emergency Leave Order
- San Jose Temporary Sick Leave COVID-19 Ordinance #30390

The Los Angeles Ordinance 186590 as Modified by the City of Los Angeles Emergency Order requires specialized language to effectuate a waiver. We will agree to language that states: "The Los Angeles Ordinance as Modified by the City of Los Angeles Emergency Order dated April 7 which requires Covid-19 benefits for certain employees within the city of Los Angeles is hereby clearly and expressly waived to the extent permitted by law."

Labor reasserts our position that the Families First Coronavirus Response Act and the San Diego Paid Leave Ordinance do not allow for a waiver through a Collective Bargaining Agreement.
